Program Vision

My vision as a head coach is to build a disciplined, competitive and purpose-driven program that develops student-athletes who excel both on and off the court. The program will pursue championships while developing leaders who demonstrate integrity, accountability and competitive toughness.

First 30 Days - Assess & Align

The first phase is to listen, evaluate and establish trust. I would meet with athletic leadership, staff, campus partners and returning student-athletes while assessing roster needs, academic performance, recruiting priorities, compliance expectations and program culture.

Days 31-60 - Build Infrastructure

The second phase is to install the operating structure of the program. This includes staff roles, player development systems, academic monitoring, recruiting boards, practice standards, communication rhythms and expectations for daily accountability.

Days 61-90 - Establish Standards

The third phase is to move from assessment into execution. Practices, workouts, recruiting, film and team communication should reflect the program's identity. Players and staff should understand what is expected, how we work and how we measure progress.

Season Build

The goal of year one is to create a foundation that can last: clear standards, disciplined habits, player growth, academic responsibility, competitive practices and a culture built on communication, accountability, toughness and service.
